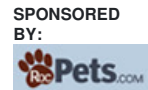

Do-it-all: Versatile swing man can bring the ball up the floor, rebound, score and swarm on defense. **Key stats:** 16.5 ppg., 7.5 rpg. **Elevation:** Named City-Catholic League Co-player of the Year and to the Section V Class AA All-Tournament team. **Next:** Looking into playing at a prep school.

Senior - Forward

Pace-setter: Led Northstar (21-6) to its first state final. **Key stats:** 21.2 ppg., 13.5 rpg., 5.2 bpg. **Honor roll:** First-team all-state.
